Our School Community

The British School of Lomé is a private, co-educational, university-preparatory, nonsectarian, Nursery to Year 13, day and boarding school. Founded almost forty years ago, BSL serves the international business and diplomatic communities of Togo. and offers the Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) and the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma. BSL faculty are highly trained, credentialed, and experienced.

The British School of Lomé occupies a beautiful campus in a prestigious, gated neighbourhood of Lomé. Facilities include modern air-conditioned classrooms, a cafeteria, a hall, four science labs, two IT labs, soccer and basketball courts, music and visual arts classrooms, and an outdoor theatre. Student boarding houses are within easy walking distance from the school, with supermarket, private gymnasium, and pool facilities available nearby. The Secondary School is located in the main campus while the primary grades are in adjacent villas. BSL Enrichment programmes include Round Square and the International Award.

Memberships and Accreditation

- A CIE accredited Test Centre (N° TG001) since 1998, BSL offers the Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) qualification for the 14 -16 age group.
- An International Baccalaureate World School (N° 0796) since 1994, BSL offers the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) for the 16 18 age groups.
- BSL works with the College Board as an official ETS Test Centre (N° 80150). The school is also registered with the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS N° B68330E). BSL is officially an IELTS examination centre since August 2023.

BSL Students Current enrolment of 275+ students from 33 nations. Togolese 19%; French 6%; USA 5%; Indian 12%; Other 58%. Most boarders hail from West Africa.

BSL Teachers BSL faculty are highly trained, credentialed, and experienced. Academic staff number 31 and represent 16 nationalities from 5 continents. European 16%; African 55%; Other 29%.

Academic Year & Organization Our 180-day school year is organised into two semester terms. Academic reviews are held every month. Six 60-minute periods per day are timetabled within a weekly schedule. When lessons are scheduled online due to Covid-19 school closures, school lessons are reduced to 45 minute periods.

Our High School Curriculum is comprised of two 2-year programmes in the final years. For the International General Certificate in Secondary Education (IGCSE), BSL students select four core subjects within a Science, Humanities or Mixed option, along with five IGCSE electives. Progression to the IB requires passing five IGCSE subjects. Year 11 students take IGCSE examinations in May. Examinations are externally moderated by Cambridge International Examinations (CIE).

Bilingual Diploma candidate, taking IB Theory of Knowledge and 3 Higher Level (HL) and 3 Standard Level (SL) courses, while completing an IB Extended Essay as well as fulfilling Creativity-Activity-Service (CAS) requirements. A few students choose to study for selected IB Courses rather than the full IB Diploma. Externally-moderated examinations are in May. BSL also offers the BSL Secondary School Diploma for successful candidates.
